DC's Report

- Adrian Cooper spoke on a number of items discussed at the last meeting. Minutes are available in the hall. NB The following is an extract from those minutes.
 - 7.3 Bruce Borlase (Mountain Districts) reported that he recently attended the Ballarat Swap Meet where he saw Rod Hadfield's newly registered vehicle and asked Con why this vehicle had no guards, no interior etc. This was also noticed by other rodders who had attended the event. Con replied that he has photo's of the complete vehicle as presented to him for SR Plates. After some discussion, Con was given a directive from the council that he is to contact Rod and insist that the vehicle be returned to the state as it was presented to Con for the final inspection. Failure to comply with request Con is to remove the plates from the vehicle.

Committee Update

Greg discussed some of the items that had been discussed at the last Committee meeting

- Further discussion took place on extending the hall. The committee has decided that the best option was to extend the hall proper into the existing bar / kitchen, and turn the existing storage area into the bar fitted with some commercial cooking appliances. This would then require a new storage area – suggestion was for one or two Shipping containers.
- Discussion took place on the “G Emonds Award” and how the points are awarded and what constituted an activity to earn points. Further discussion was had regarding the ‘accuracy’ of some of the points claimed for attending events. This makes it difficult for Clinton to total the points for those that have attended the events.
- Changes to new members car inspection. It was agreed that Peter DeBruyn would arrange inspection of the potential new members cars after the 1st meeting. Greg to confirm with the visitor of their intent on joining the club & Dave Murphy to get their contact details.
- With some changes to the old committee Peter Laude has agreed to take on the position of “Official Raffle Boy”, Mark V will continue as “Master Chef”
- Constitution Amendments. Peter Raines presented the committee with 3 proposed changes to the Constitution. This was tabled to all committee members in attendance. These were for
 - Non Attendance (to club meetings)
 - Loss of ASRF classified club vehicle
 - Resumption of MembershipAfter a long discussion on changes 1 & 2 a vote was held to pass the amendments. Both changes were rejected. Change 3 was deemed void as it relied on change 2 being passed. This will need to be explained at the club meeting
